

Eagle In One Golf Ball Drop - Official Rules and Regulations

1. **The Contest:** Participants, 18 years or older, can purchase numbered raffle tickets associated to a numbered golf ball for: 1 ball for \$10 or 3 balls for \$25; which will be entered into the Eagle In One Golf Ball Drop to take place on September 20, 2019 at 6:00pm at the Eagle River Golf Course, 457 E. McKinley St., Eagle River, WI 54521. Participants may purchase more than once. Participants will be assigned a numbered golf ball (maximum of 1500) which corresponds to the number on each raffle ticket purchased.
2. **The Drop:** All purchased numbered golf balls will be placed randomly into a container and dropped from the Eagle Light and Water Utility Bucket Truck from a height of approximately 40 feet onto the assigned target. The participant whose ball is closest to the pin will be declared the winner of the Eagle In One Golf Ball Drop and will be awarded the Grand Prize.
3. **Prize:** The Grand prize shall be \$1,000.00.
4. **Rules:** The participant whose ball lands closest to the pin will be declared the Grand Prize winner as determined by the independent judges. The Winner is determined by the measurement of the golf ball from the pin. If the judges determine that there is a tie among the golf balls than each ball will be declared a winner and the Grand Prize will be shared equally among the winners.
5. **Announcement of Grand Prize Winner:** The winner needs not to be present to win. The winner will be announced immediately at the Eagle In One Golf Outing Dinner which follows the Eagle In One Ball Drop at the Eagle River Golf Course. If the winner is not present, the winner will be called and told of their winning within the week following September 20, 2019.
6. **Alternative Process:** If some unforeseen event prevents the Eagle In One Golf Ball Drop from being conducted, then the winner will be determined by the following alternative. Within a week of the scheduled event, all purchased Golf Ball raffle tickets will be placed into a container and an independent judge selected by the organizers will draw the winner.
7. **Purchasing Tickets:** Eagle In One Golf Ball Drop Raffle tickets (up to 1500) will be available for sale at the Eagle River Area Chamber of Commerce, The

Eagle River Golf Course, through Eagle River Chamber Board members, staff and event volunteers, and at special events held throughout the area. The cost of each raffle ticket is: 1 for \$10 or 3 for \$25. Tickets are not refundable. Tickets will be available for sale until 5pm on September 20, 2019 or until all tickets have been sold should that happen prior to September 20, 2019.

8. Tracking Tickets: The Executive Director of the Eagle River Area Chamber of Commerce will be responsible for maintaining the list of tickets sold with name, phone number and email of the purchaser of each ticket and will have the list available for auditing and inspection by the Board of Directors of the Chamber and any interested members of the public to insure the openness and integrity of the Eagle In One Golf Ball Drop Raffle.
9. Eligible Participants: Participants must be 18 years of age or older to purchase a ticket and win the prize. All officers, board members, staff, volunteers of the Eagle River Area Chamber of Commerce, the City of Eagle River and the Eagle River Golf Course are eligible to purchase tickets and to win the prize, however; the independent judges who will decide the winner of the golf ball drop are ineligible to win. Verification of eligibility and identity may be required before releasing the prize.
10. Notification of Winner: If the winner is not present at the time of the golf ball drop, then the winner will be notified by phone call and/or email. If the winner can not be located within 30 days after the notifications, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to the Eagle River Area Chamber of Commerce to be used to support its purposes.
11. Miscellaneous:
 - a. Odds of winning depend on the number of valid entries (up to 1500) received by the deadline set forth above.
 - b. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply.
 - c. Void where prohibited by law.
 - d. All federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the individual winner.
 - e. The funds raised at this event will be used to support the programs of the Eagle River Area Chamber of Commerce and Visitors Center – a not-for-profit 501 (c)6 organization.

- f. Decisions by the Eagle In One Golf Ball Drop judges on all aspects of the raffle will be binding and final.
 - g. The prize will not be awarded and will be forfeited if the ticket was issued by a check returned for insufficient funds.
 - h. Tickets can be purchased by check or cash.
 - i. The Eagle In One Golf Ball Drop Committee may amend these rules as appropriate to ensure the fairness and original intent of the contest.
 - j. The funds for tickets to this raffle are not tax deductible.
 - k. The source of funds to award the Grand prize is the general asset of the Eagle River Area Chamber of Commerce and Visitors Center.
12. Release of Liability: By participating, each participant releases, discharges, indemnifies and holds harmless the Eagle River Area Chamber of Commerce and Visitors Center Organization, the City of Eagle River, the Eagle River Golf Course, Eagle River Light And Water, and affiliated companies/organizations, and their staff, board of directors, volunteers, sponsors, agents and representative from any and all liability, loss, harm, injury, damage, cost and expense whatsoever arising directly or indirectly from the receipt of the prize or participation in the raffle.
